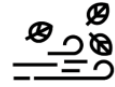

## One Act Recognition!

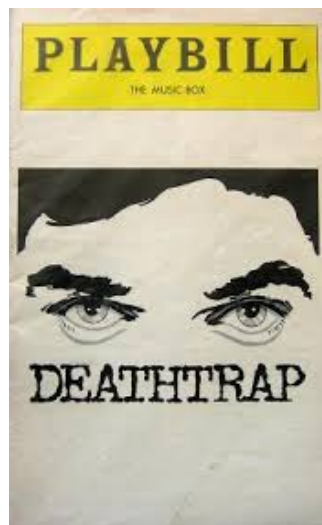
## Deathtrap Teaser!

This play involves five actors - 2 men, 2 women and one lawyer

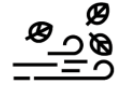
